Kansas Certified Business Statute 75-3740	Kansas Use Law Vendor Statute 75-3317 through 75-3322	Kansas Corporate Tax Credit Qualifying Vendor
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• For profit or nonprofit entity</li><li>• Business activity conducted primarily in Kansas</li><li>• At least 10% of employees must be individuals with disabilities residing in Kansas.</li><li>• Contribute 75% of health insurance premium</li><li>• Pays minimum wage or greater</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Nonprofit entity</li><li>• Business activity conducted by nonprofit incorporated in the state of Kansas</li><li>• Operated in the interest of and for the benefit of persons who are blind or have other severe disabilities or both</li><li>• Net income of entity shall not, in whole or any part, financially benefit any shareholder or other individual</li><li>• Qualified vendor's primary purpose shall be to provide employment for persons who are blind or have other severe disabilities</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Nonprofit Certified Business or Use Law Vendor that meets the additional criteria as a qualifying vendor for offering Kansas corporate tax credits under this statute</li><li>• Business activity conducted primarily in Kansas or substantially all of its production in Kansas</li><li>• At least 30% of employees must be individuals with disabilities who reside in Kansas</li><li>• Contribute 75% of health insurance premium (or alternative – see statute)</li><li>• Pays minimum wage or greater</li></ul>
